1. Completed [Degree Application Summary](#) form.
2. Completed [Bellevue College Bachelor Programs Admission Application](#).
3. A Non-refundable check for \$125, payable to Bellevue College Interior Design BAA. (If you reapply for admission within 12 months, the fee will be waived.)
4. Official sealed transcripts from a regionally accredited college, demonstrating
 - An interior design-related associate's degree, or the equivalent, totaling 90 credits which includes:
Art History (5 Cr)
Science (5 Cr)
English Composition (5 Cr)
Quantitative and Symbolic Reasoning (5 Cr)
Social Science (5 Cr)
 - Cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better.
 - Bellevue College students currently enrolled in the interior design associate degree program must have completed, INDES 260 or INDES 280 prior to the quarter for which they are applying.
5. Two sealed letters of recommendation, on official [Recommendation Form](#). (Recommendations will be kept on file for twelve months.)
6. A portfolio of creative work that conforms to the following guidelines.

Portfolio Guidelines

BC's BAA in Interior Design program seeks students who will make a positive contribution to our diverse, dynamic, and supportive learning community. The portfolio review process is designed to identify candidates with the potential for academic success in a challenging and competitive discipline.

Submit a portfolio that documents your creative work process and product, demonstrates your ability to conceptualize ideas and communicate design intent, and characterizes your creative ambitions.

The reviewers will evaluate the portfolio and contents based on these criteria:

- Technical skills
- Design skills
- Ability to communicate design intent

Note: Evidence of design intent presumes that the reviewers understand the problems addressed in your design projects, so *concise* problem statements and captions are encouraged. Clearly describe your specific role in any design project where you participated as part of a design team – either as a professional or a student.

- Submit in a bound format no larger than 12" x 18"
- Twelve (12) pages maximum of your creative work. You may use the front and back of each page, for a total of 24 presentation faces. Do not include slides, disks, CDs, unbound work, or drawings in tubes. Be sure to include your name within the portfolio.
- You may include originals, photographs and/or other reproductions of your creative work; however, *THE PORTFOLIO WILL NOT BE RETURNED*. It becomes the property of the Bellevue College Interior Design Department.
