- If you are 16, 17, or 18 years old, you must also bring the GED underage permission form signed by a high school counselor or administrator.

Taking the GED Test

Examinees who have attended an orientation and paid the fee will be eligible to take any GED subject test on any test date administered by the GED office. No appointment is needed, but be **ON TIME**. No late admission. Accommodations available upon request.
