What is an Imaging Aide?

This 16-credit certificate helps you prepare for entry level work in hospital and clinic radiology departments supporting imaging technologists. Imaging Aides prepare rooms and equipment for procedures and assist with basic patient care. Typical salary is \$12 – \$15 per hour.*

Program Enrollment Options

Courses in this short-term training program should be taken together. You can enroll in the 9-week summer session, or the two-quarter evening program beginning January 2010.

Summer Session

- 9-week program
- Late June–August
- Twice a week on-campus & online

Winter-Spring Session

- Start in January, complete certificate in June
- 8 credits per quarter for 2 quarters
- Courses are in the evening & online

2. If you are a new student, complete BC admissions application.
3. Complete the Imaging Aide enrollment form and submit it to Imaging Programs, room A251.
4. After you receive confirmation that you have been admitted to the program, register and pay for your courses.
