# Associate Degree Nursing Program (Full-Time Option)

The Associate Degree in Nursing Program prepares graduates for beginning level clinical practice as Registered Nurses. Graduates are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses. The license to practice Registered Nursing in the state of Washington is granted by the Washington State Nursing Care Quality Assurance Commission. The curriculum is designed so that prerequisite and general education classes are completed prior to the six quarters of nursing course work. The program is one of selective admission with full time lecture classes scheduled during the day and clinical hours scheduled during day and evening hours.

## Attend Information Sessions

Applicants are required to attend one of the information sessions conducted by faculty. During these sessions, the program and admission process are discussed. The scheduled times for these sessions can be obtained on the Nursing Program website or by calling the program office at (425) 564-2012.

## Application Deadline:

The online application will be available beginning November 1, 2011. The application deadline for 2012/2013 admission is Feb. 3, 2012.

## Selection Criteria

Selection is based on **1)**. The number of general education credits completed with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 with no less than 2.0 in any course; **2)**. Ranking by TEAS score with a minimum of 74%. In the event of a tie, GPA ranking will be considered.

The application is for entry to fall 2012 or winter 2013. Using the selection criteria above, the first group of students will have entrance in winter quarter. Any openings in fall quarter will be filled with students eligible for winter entry. An alternate list will be used to fill openings in winter quarter.

## Application Status Notification

Applicants will be notified in April of admission to fall, winter, alternate list, or not qualified.

## 2012/13 Admission Requirements

### TEAS Score

(Valid Test Dates – From February 5, 2011 to February 3, 2012)

*You must take Version V TEAS test. Other versions will not be accepted. A minimum score of 74 is required. TEAS must be completed within the valid test date period (2/5/11 - 2/3/12) and cannot be taken more than two times in the same period. If you took TEAS at other institutions, you need to request an official transcript through ATI ([www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com)). A copy of your score report will NOT be accepted.*

*It is required that all general education courses be completed prior to application to the program. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required with a minimum of 2.0 in any given course.*

*All qualified applicants must provide a proctored writing sample and may have an interview with admission committee and nursing faculty.*
