

OLS Admissions & Financial Aid Checklist

- **Attend OLS Informational Meeting**
 - Held several times each quarter
 - See http://bellevuecollege.edu/ols/learn_more/news/informational.pdf for dates, times and location

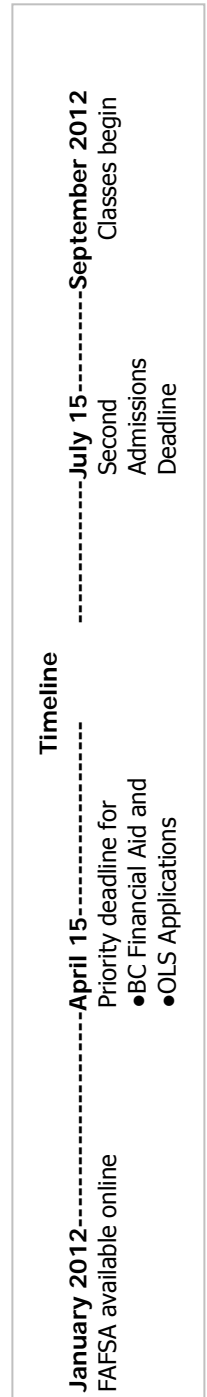
- **Is the student eligible for OLS? Initial application requirements include:**
 - 4th grade reading, writing and math level
 - IQ 70 and above

- **OLS Application Packet : Due April 15, 2012 for priority admissions or July 15, 2012 for second admissions**
 - Application on BC website <http://bellevuecollege.edu/ols>
 - OLS Student Admissions Application and \$54 application fee
 - Educational evaluation conducted within the last 3 years
 - Current Reading, writing and math levels
 - IQ scores with testing completed *after age 16*
 - Two recommendations from vocational or educational professionals who have known the applicant at least 6 months
 - Official High School transcript and any postsecondary program records

- **ALL students seeking admission to OLS should apply for financial aid Begin Jan. 2012**

Note: 60-90 days are required for the financial aid office to evaluate application and produce an award letter. Begin this process sooner rather than later.

- **OLS Admissions Assessment—after application has been submitted**
 - Student interview
 - OLS specific reading, writing, computer, and math assessment
 - Notification of acceptance/rejection occurs within 2 weeks of interview date



Upon successful completion of the above steps, admitted students are eligible to register for Fall 2012 OLS courses.
