- Identify strategies for marketing sustainable options on campus and implement marketing strategy
- Increase access to and organization of data pertaining to student food preferences on campus
- Assist with Annual Student Survey find student opinion on food options, include question on sustainability
- Continue work with Food Services on food-related issues including equitable access, labeling, food system options, and education.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Minimum 2.7 cumulative BC college-level GPA at the time of application or 2.7 cumulative quarterly BC college-level GPA for the two (2) previous consecutive quarters, and maintain a minimum 2.7 cumulative BC college-level GPA throughout employment term.
- Must be registered for a minimum of (6) BC credits during Winter quarter and as many BC credits as needed during winter quarter for graduation purposes.
- Must have completed a minimum of (12) college level credits at the time of application.
