BryteWave and Pearson Partnership Integrations. For Follett Customers, the BryteWave Course Materials Tools are all instructors and students need for one stop access to their Pearson Courseware. There are two tools:


1. The BryteWave Course Materials Link in your Canvas course provides access to your shelf of learning materials for your courses.
2. The BryteWave Deep Link Tool allows instructors to create deep links to assignments and activities in their Pearson Courseware. Students can click on these links to go directly into their assignments.

This single set of tools provides access to your Pearson products, deep linking, and grade transfer through your Canvas Learning Management System. No additional tools are required. The instructions provided explain how instructors pair to their Courseware, access their course materials, and how to create deep links. 

BryteWave courseware access for Instructors


1. Log into your Canvas course, go to the BryteWave Course Materials Module and select the **BryteWave Course Materials** link.



2. Select to Load BryteWave Course Materials in a new window.
3. Select your courseware under Your Materials.








How to create Pearson assignment deep links


1. Open your Canvas course and choose a module. Select the + button to add a deep link to the module.



2. Using the drop down choose External Tool then select **BryteWave Deep Link**.




3. Choose **My Materials** and you will be presented with Courseware to choose from.



4. Select Launch to Courseware.




5. Choose 1 or more boxes and then select **Add Links** at the bottom of the page.



You will then be presented with the RedShelf screen. Proceed with closing this screen.



6. You will then be directed back to your Canvas course showing the items you deep linked. Be sure to publish links you wish students to access.



Set up Pearson grade sync


Important if you are using a Canvas course copied from a previous course integrated with Pearson assignments that did not use Follett BryteWave, you will need to [Remove old Canvas assignments](#) before setting up grade sync.

- To reduce student confusion, also remove the VitalSource IA link in your Canvas left menu from Settings and then Navigation.


Pearson synced grades do not populate Canvas assignment due dates at this time.

To set up grade sync for your Pearson course:


1. Log into your Canvas course, go to the BryteWave Course Materials Module and select the **BryteWave Course Materials** link.




2. Select to Load BryteWave Course Materials in a new window.
3. Select your courseware under Your Materials.



4. Select Access Courseware.



o Select Grade Sync if you're using MyLab or Mastering.



5. To automatically sync grades as they become available, select **On** for Automatic Grade Sync.

Important This doesn't sync past grades. (If Off is selected, MLM grades only sync to Canvas when you select Sync Grades Now.)

6. Use **Sync Grades Now** or **Sync Now** anytime to manually sync all existing grades, including grades available before you turned auto sync on.

7. Make selections in the Items to Sync or assignments list. You might need to wait up to 15 minutes after you set up grade sync to see these items.
